



Cultural Journeys to Enrich Classroom Instruction *NY City's Left Bank: Greenwich Village (PART A)**

Through lecture, discussion, multimedia resources, literary critique and a guided tour of the neighborhood, participants will learn the historical significance of Greenwich Village as well as its impact on society, the sciences, and the arts. Topics such as Bohemians, artists, literary masters, architectural geniuses, like Stanford White, and “The Murder of the Century” will be covered in this course. We will also discuss the origin of *NYU* and some of its famous professors and the beginnings of the *Whitney Museum*. Teachers of different grade levels and subjects will gain insight into NYC’s glorious history and its culture. At the end of the course, you will have enough information to design a grade appropriate lesson.

New Course Registration Procedure

District Subscribers: If your district already subscribes to *MLP*, you will find the teacher center courses integrated in your local professional development catalog. Follow your district’s login procedures and click on *The Edith Winthrop Teacher Center*. Your district’s approval will occur online through *My Learning Plan*. Once you have registered, you will receive an email stating that your registration is pending. An email confirming your approved registration will be sent after your internal approval process is completed electronically.

Nonsubscribers are required to register as a *MLP* participant. Registration is free, only has to be done once, and does not obligate you or your district in any way. You can use any email address to register but you will need to remember the address you choose for future registrations. Once you have registered, you can use *MLP* for all Teacher Center course registrations.
