Course Registration Procedure

District Subscribers: If your district already subscribes to *MLP*, you will find our course offerings integrated in your local professional development catalog. Follow your district's login procedures and click on *The Edith Winthrop Teacher Center*. Your district's approval will occur online through *My Learning Plan*. Once you have registered, you will receive an email stating that your registration is pending. An email confirming your approved registration will be sent after your internal approval process is completed electronically.

Nonsubscribers are required to register as a *MLP* participant. Log on to our website: www.ewteachercenter.org and click on *Westchester Institute for Teachers*. Registration is free, only has to be done once, and does not obligate you or your district in any way.
